The Viking Studies undergraduate minor consists of courses that meet the following requirements:

Cluster A: students must take at least 12 credits from a selection of approved courses; an up-to-date listing of approved courses is maintained by the Program in Medieval Studies and available for consultation on the Program's website: <<http://medievalstudies.cornell.edu>>. Courses taken at other universities (e.g. at Ithaca College, while studying abroad) and appropriate academic work not in course form (e.g. participation in Cornell extension work, archaeological digs) may also qualify for credit towards the minor. Please document the nature of the work and its relevance to the minor as fully as possible (e.g. by retaining syllabi, assignment descriptions) to enable consideration for Viking Studies credit.

Cluster B: students must take one of two capstone courses, ENGL 3080 (4 credits) "Sagas and Eddas: Introduction to Old Norse-Icelandic Literature" or HIST 3200 (4 credits) "The Viking World." Students who take both capstone courses may count 4 credits as fulfilling the requirements for Cluster A.
